<i>This wine making family's heritage goes back over 500 years to the Mosel River in Germany. Keeping traditional methods during the wine making process, fermentation is carried out in French barriques. This wine has a mouthfilling texture and a richness unlike any other wine of its type, a very special example.</i>

Exhibiting classic Cabernet flavours of mint, tobacco and chocolate giving an intriguing mix with the wines grainy tannins.*
